- 4 ☐ Londoners and tourists from around the world come to Soho for its variety of theatres. There are many plays and musicals to see in different venues in this arty neighbourhood. For more information on performances, see Time Out London magazine.
- 5 ☐ Soho is truly an international spot. People from all over the world come together in the streets of Soho. Of course, with all these nationalities living in one neighbourhood, there is a wide variety of food choices. Great ethnic cuisine from just about everywhere is available in Soho, so get ready for a delicious treat.
- 6 ☐ The streets are always busy in Soho. People there like to go out and have a great time. There is no better way to have fun and really live the Soho experience than to attend one of the many festivals that take place throughout the year. Festivals celebrating music, the arts, films and food guarantee a fun time in this lively neighbourhood.
- 7 ☐ The neighbourhood of Soho covers 2.6 square kilometres and is in the shape of a square. There are four underground Tube stations that give access to Soho; one in each corner of the square.
